Cancellation/Refund Checks Policy: Try-out fees are non-fundable. Participation fee refunds will be offered only to those with a written medical excuse. Refunds will be prorated based upon the total program offered up until the first game of the season, after which no refunds can be made. Returned checks will require payment of an additional \$25 administrative fee.

Divisions: Mite – Squirt – PeeWee – Bantam

Twenty (20) players maximum, sixteen (16) players minimum per team. To be eligible for championships, a player must play in at least 50% of regular season games. All players will play "up" to their 2010/2011 USA age classification. (example: a second year PeeWee player will play at the Bantam level in the CAHL)

Players should play at the CT facility that is closest to their home. Out of state players are accepted. League play will culminate in Championship Tournament.

League Championship Tournament – all teams participate in playoffs – locations & times T.B.A.

Fees & Registration (All Checks are made payable to CAHL)

\$265 per Mite & Squirt & PeeWee; \$295 per Bantam player. Plus, \$40 per player try-out fee add \$25.00 for non-USA players). Team jerseys are provided.

Format of Play

15-Minute full stop time periods for Bantam teams.
12-Minute full stop time periods for Mites & Squirt & PeeWee teams.
